Rendezvous: At 1030 at CBYRA "B" - Susquehanna River Junction Light SN in approximate position 39

degrees 26.653 minutes N, 76 degrees 2.124 minutes West.

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 71 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee.

Start: Between yellow flag on Race Committee boat and Region 1 Mark "B" (SN). If code flag "L" is

displayed, the starting line may be moved to between yellow flag on Race Committee boat and another navigation aid or a temporary mark. Boats must start within 30 minutes of their

start time to be scored.

Boats whose class warning signal has not been made <u>shall keep clear</u> of the starting area. At the discretion of the Race Committee, the race may be delayed to await favorable winds O - D enotes event does not qualify for CBYRA High Point. (If a fleet has less than three boats, they may be combined with another fleet at the discretion of the Race Committee.)

Course: Designated by letters and numbers displayed on the Race Committee boat referencing special

race buoy drop-marks or government marks based on Region 1 Standard Racing Marks.

Finish: Between yellow flag on Race Committee boat and last posted mark, unless course is

shortened after the start at a designated mark of the course.

Time Limit: 4.5 hours from the start for each class for each boat in the class. This changes RRS 35.

Rules: This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024

(RRS). RRS 63.7, Conflict between Rules, is replaced by, "If there is a conflict between the Event Sailing Instructions and the Notice of Race, the Event Sailing Instructions shall apply."

Protests: Postmarked on first business day after the race, sent to the entry address. Protest hearing

time and place to be announced. No protests accepted the day of the event.

Awards: Collectable hand painted/signed decoy duck trophies will be presented at the post-race social

or mailed to recipients depending on pandemic conditions. Awards will be for 1st place for classes with 3 boats registered, 1st and 2nd place for classes with 5 boats registered, and 1st,

2nd, and 3rd place for classes with 7+ boats.

Social: A post-race party will be held at Tidewater Marina, Havre de Grace. For those travelling from

out of town a limited number of FREE overnight slips will still be available for participating race boats. Do not contact the marina for slip information; please email: events@hdgyc.org for additional information on slips. Party and dinner registration will be announced separately

unsafe weather race may be postponed to the next suitable weekend.
